Theological Commitments

- Candidates must affirm ICF's statement faith without reservations. (If they have specific reservations or concerns, they should be stated in writing.)
- Candidates should be theologically trained appropriate to preaching and teaching on a regular basis.
- Candidates should demonstrate a solid foundation, understanding, and application of the scriptures.
- Candidates must accept the interdenominational nature of ICF and support unity between the believers.

Character Qualities

Biblical Requirements of Elders

As the ICF Pastor will be a member of the Elder team, candidates should have the character qualities that are identified as requirements for Elders in the New Testament. These qualities are identified primarily in 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9, Hebrews 13:7, and 1 Peter 5:1-3.

NOTE: Based on ICF's interpretation of biblical passages for Elders, only male candidates will be considered.

Specific to ICF Pastor Role

We have discerned that some qualities are beneficial specifically to the pastor position at ICF in additional to biblical qualifications. Candidates should exhibit a moderate threshold level of all these qualities.

- 1. Teaches from the Bible
- 2. He has a growing love for Jesus Christ
- 3. Humble
- 4. Sensitive to the Holy Spirit
- 5. He possesses and practices discipline in his life
- 6. He is dedicated to reading the Word of God
- 7. He remains accountable
- 8. Patient and forgiving
- 9. He prays for others
- 10. He possesses a sense of urgency for God's work

- 11. He stands on strong Biblical convictions
- 12. Mission field work experience beneficial
- 13. Must speak English fluently; Spanish is desirable
